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Rules:

- Judges in ladies work are authorized by the Directors of the Society to discard all soiled, defaced or old work and are instructed to award prizes for new and up-to-date work. No article may be shown more than two years.
- In classes where there is no competition, unless the exhibit is worthy, the prize will be withheld.
- Articles are not to be placed until judged. Prize money will be forfeited if exhibits are removed before 4:30 p.m. final day. Name must be on entry tag or money will be forfeited. Must be clearly stated on back of entry ticket if it was a winner at any other fair.
- **NO** straight pins attaching entry tags

Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS)

Annual Hand Quilted Championship Quilt Competition

- A. Entries must be solely made and hand quilted by the exhibitor and exhibited and judged at a local Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS) to be eligible for this competition.
- B. Entry quilts must be a minimum of 324" measured on the perimeter (smaller quilts will not be eligible to proceed to the next level of competition)
- C. The winner's name and pattern to be displayed at the Fair on sign provided by OAAS.
- D. Judging will occur at local fairs and district levels. A Provincial Grand Champion Quilt will be selected at the Annual OAAS Convention.
- E. Upon making an entry into the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Quilt Competition, the Exhibitor agrees to participate in any promotional activities related to the competition.
- F. The winning Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Champion Quilt will not be eligible to compete in any future District and/or Convention OAAS competition.

Local Fair Competition

1. **Local fair is entitled to send only the Grand Champion Quilt, (min. 324" measured on the perimeter)** judged the best of show of all hand quilted quilts to the District Competition. **OR** If any entry wins GRAND CHAMPION or BEST of ALL ELIGIBLE QUILTS at more than one Fair, the other Fairs at which this quilt was entered and won, should enter their RESERVE CHAMPION or SECOND BEST OF SHOW OF ALL CLASSES quilt in the District Competition.

NOTE: If an Exhibitor wins GRAND CHAMPION or BEST of SHOW of ALL ELIGIBLE quilts at other than his/her own fair, or at more than one Fair, the Exhibitor must consider the Agricultural Society nearest his/her home address as the one from which the quilt will be sent to the District meeting.

2. An Exhibitor who wins more than one Best of Show title with a different quilt at different Fairs shall be entitled to enter each winning quilt to compete at the District Competition.
3. Local Homecraft Divisions are requested to judge a GRAND CHAMPION or BEST of SHOW of all ELIGIBLE quilts. As well as RESERVE Grand Champion or SECOND Best of Show of all ELIGIBLE quilts. The GRAND CHAMPION and the RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION are judged from all first and second prize ELIGIBLE quilts.

Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS)

Annual Machine-Quilted Championship Quilt Competition

ELIGIBILITY, RULES AND REGULATIONS: General Conditions

- A. Quilt must be solely made and machine quilted by the exhibitor and exhibited and judged at a local Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS) fair to be eligible for this competition.
- B. Quilt to be measured on the perimeter .Total perimeter measurement to be a minimum of 324 inches .Note the quilt can be square, rectangular etc.
- C. Judging will occur at local fairs and district levels. A Provincial Grand Champion Machine Quilted Quilt will be selected at the Annual OAAS Convention.
- D. Upon making entry into the OAAS Machine Quilting Competition, the Exhibitor agrees to participate in any promotional activities related to the competition.
- E. The winning OAAS Machine Quilted Quilt will not be eligible to compete in any future District and/or OAAS Provincial competition.
- F. The winner's name to be displayed at the Fair on sign provided by OAAS.
- G. Quilt must have visible machine quilting.

Local Fair Competition

Annual Hand Quilted Quilt & Machine-Quilted Quilt/Wall Hanging

Local Fair Competition

1 Each local fair is entitled to send only one Grand Champion Machine-Quilted Quilt, judged best of show of all eligible machine quilted Quilt to the District Competition **OR** If any entry wins *Grand Champion* or *Best of Show* of all eligible *Machine-Quilted Quilts* at more than one Fair, the other Fairs at which this item was entered and won, should enter their *Reserve Champion* or *Second Best of Show* of eligible Machine-Quilted Quilt in the District Competition.

NOTE: If an Exhibitor wins *Grand Champion* or *Best of Show* of all eligible *Machine-Quilted classes* at other than his/her own fair, or at more than one Fair, the Exhibitor must consider the Agricultural Society nearest his/her home address as the one from which the Quilt will be sent to the District competition.

2. An Exhibitor who wins more than one Best of Show title with a different machine quilted Quilt at different Fairs shall be entitled to enter each winning Quilt to compete at the District Competition
3. Local Homecraft Divisions are requested to judge a *Grand Champion* or *Best of Show* of all eligible *Machine-Quilted Quilt* as well as a *Reserve Champion* or *Second Best of Show* of eligible Machine-Quilted Quilt.



The Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion are judged from all first and second prize ELIGIBLE machine quilted Quilts.

HAND-QUILTED-ELIGIBLE FOR DISTRICT COMPETITION (min. 324” measured on the perimeter for district competition)

All Quilts entered will be judged at the local level and prizes awarded in both hand and machine quilted categories with those eligible for O.A.A.S. competition judged in Championship and Reserve Championship. If not entering in district competition quilts can be any size to enter locally.

Prizes: 1st \$12.00 2nd \$10.00 3rd \$8.00

Quilts in section 1 – 4 must be made and quilted by exhibitor.

1. Quilt, pieced (pattern named) not a sampler
– Sponsored by Purrsonally Yours, prizes paid in gift cards
2. Quilt, appliquéd, pattern named, hand quilted
Sponsored by Fabric Centre, Owen Sound
3. Quilt, embroidered-whole cloth (plain material, fancy quilting)-pattern named
Sponsored by Herb & Marie Hubbard in memory of Viola Hubbard
4. Quilt, any kind, hand quilted
Sponsored by the Morris Memorials, Meaford

Quilts in sections 5 – 8 can be made by any individual or group and hand quilted by a group and can be twin, double, queen or king size.

5. Quilt, sampler, minimum of 12 different blocks

6. Quilt, pieced and appliqued by hand, quilted by hand
Sponsored by the Meaford & St. Vincent Agricultural Society
7. Scrap quilt-at least 12 different fabrics

8. Rag Quilt-any size *sponsored by the Georgian Quilters Guild*

MACHINE-QUILTED-ELIGIBLE FOR DISTRICT COMPETITION (min. 324” measured on the perimeter for district competition)

If not entering in district competition quilts can be any size to enter locally

Prizes: 1st \$12.00 2nd \$10.00 3rd \$8.00

9. Quilt any variety-quilted by machine made solely by exhibitor and machine quilted by exhibitor
10. Machine Quilt made by individual or group-not necessarily quilted by group of individual
11. Pieced & Appliqued -machine quilted
12. Plain cloth quilted by machine
13. Scrap quilt-at least 2 different materials-machine quilted
14. Sample quilt-every block different machine quilted-preprinted blocks

Exhibitor must register with secretary either on Thursday August 29, 7-9 pm or Friday August 31st, 9-noon. No entry fee if antique quilt is the only entry. *Sponsored by Ivan & Verla Cramp-White*
