- e. Entries must be deemed by the judges to be of good quality to be worthy of a prize.

SECTION 1: MINI-SCARECROW COMPETITION

SECTION 2: VEGETABLES AND FRUIT

TIPS: Look for most uniform collection of vegetables and fruit. Gently brush off soil. Leave 1 inch of stems. No age categories for this class. Display on a sturdy paper plate.

- 1. 2 cucumbers
- 2. 3 carrots
- 3. 3 onions
- 4. 3 tomatoes
- 5. 5 beans-green or yellow
- 6. Largest potato
- 7. Longest zucchini
- 8. Vegetable vehicle (car, plane, boat, etc)
- 9. Pumpkin-largest circumference

SECTION 3: FLOWERS

Bloom: an individual flower, one to a stem with no buds showing colour

Stem: may carry one or more flowers and buds

Spray: a portion of the plant with a number of flowers or buds on one stem

Arrangement: can have greenery from other plants and should cover the container's lip

TIPS: Make sure your container has water and is weighted so it won't tip. Put in some matching greenery (without flowers). Look for flowers without buds or blemishes and blooms with uniformity in size and shape. Judges look for appealing colour, appropriate internal texture, tender & crisp flower.

- 11. Bouquet of one colour-1 or more varieties of flowers
- 12. One spike of gladioli
- 13. Pansies, 5 flowers

14. One rose floating in a clear disposable container (not crammed)
15. Bouquet of petunias

18. Chrysanthemums-3 blooms
19. Sunflower-largest head
20. Sunflower-tallest, no roots

Judges look for:

- Pleasing appearance
- Appealing colour and visual texture
- Appropriate size and shape
- Appropriate internal texture
- Tender, crisp, smooth, fluffy, flaky, creamy or crunchy rather than greasy, sticky, rubbery, lumpy, tough or stringy
- Colour-even and appropriate
- Appropriate aroma for baked goods

Arts & Crafts

- Attracts attention with its colour and designs
- Accurate dimensions
- Work looks finished
- Design is creative, appealing and functional
- Creative colour suits the design and is harmonious
- Creative material choice suited to use of the article and compliments the design
- Craftsmanship shows knowledge and understanding of the materials

Printing

- Paper size is correct
- Not mounted
- Round letters are to be round, vertical letters straight, not slanted
- Letters are to be of uniform and correct height, spaced appropriately, and have proper shape

Creative Writing

- Paper size is correct
- Not mounted
- Letters are to be uniform height, spaced appropriately, and have proper shape
- Looped letters must be open (i.e. e, l, f, g, h)
- Dots on i's are to be dots, not circles
- No "white out" used
